Where Is the Headquarters of Your Church?

Have you been asked, "Where is the head of the church to which you belong?"

The only right answer is "in heaven." If a person belongs to a church that has headquarters on earth somewhere, whether Indianapolis, Nashville, St. Louis, Philadelphia, Rome, or some other city, he belongs to the wrong church, for the right church has its headquarters higher up than that.

Christ resides in heaven, seated at the God's right hand, and He is the only Head of the church (Colossians 1:18). Colossians was written thirty years after Christ ascended to heaven. He left no vicar here on earth. Christ is King in the kingdom of heaven, and is head of the church.

He is its founder, for He said, "On this rock I will build My church" (Matthew 16:18). He is its director, guiding it in all its ways. He is the door of the church (John 10:9), and He is the chief cornerstone (Ephesians 2:20). Belief in Christ's divinity is the creed of the church.

There are many metaphors used in Scripture to describe the church. It is called a family, a kingdom, a vineyard, a flock, a building, and a bride. But the most profound metaphor—one having no Old Testament equivalent—is that of a body.

The church is a body, and Christ is the head of the body. This concept is not used in the sense of the head of a company, but rather looks at the church as a living organism, inseparably tied together by the living Christ.

He is the head of the body, the church; not only a head of government and direction, as the king is the head of the state and has right to prescribe laws, but a head of vital influence, as the head in the natural body.

Christ is preeminent in His church (Ephesians 1:1-3; 5:23; Acts 2:36). The headquarters of the church are where the head is "quartered." —Oran Rhodes

Don't Believe Everything You Think

I admit a curiosity for bumper stickers. On occasion, one succinctly states a great truth or at least provokes reasonable thought.

Once I stopped at a light, and the car in front of mine had the sticker, "Don't believe everything you think!" The more I thought about it, that statement struck me as appropriate.

Often people reason, "If I think it, it must be right." The press and the politicians seem to believe that if one repeats something often enough, even if it is wrong, people will believe it. When people decide that this propaganda is what they believe, then it must be right.

While the mores of society are in transition, morality is not. Society thinks that we have a new morality, but thinking it does not make it so.

In spiritual matters, the dangers and consequences are so much more serious because they affect the eternal. Naaman made this mistake because things did not turn out as he thought they would. He became furious, saying, "Indeed, I said to myself, 'He will surely come out to me, and stand and call on the name of the Lord his God, and wave his hand over the place, and heal the leprosy'" (2 Kings 5:11).

Because of his thinking, Naaman could have lost the opportunity for healing simply because what God, through Elisha, required was not what Naaman thought it should be. People reject God's plan of salvation because it differs from what they think. Different folks think that God ought to save them by certain means— faith only, sprinkling, good works. Others think God should save them in their sins, not from their sins.

Many become indignant when it is suggested that what they are practicing— whether in worship, works, or manner of life—does not have God's approval according to the Scriptures. The defense offered is that this is what attracts people, what pleases people, and what people think they should do.

A good reminder to all men is, "My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways," says the Lord. 'For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts'" (Isaiah 55:8-9).

Whether it is our judgments about our fellow man, about the world around us, or about our responsibility to God, remember that in every case truth should be the measuring standard. Please, do not believe everything you think!
